The spacious galley allows for food preparation to take place whilst still being in contact with guests in the saloon and cockpit areas.

The saloon/entertainment area flows through to an enormous cockpit designed for optimum ergonomics.

The Lightwave Powercat 46' stands out with new features and elements. Sporting our unique stepped fly bridge design, the commanding seating position ensures all of the advantages associated with the traditional fly bridge without isolating the captain from family members and guests.

At first sight the Powercat 46' exudes a flair of powerful dynamism. Fitted with twin 160hp Volvo diesel engines with shaft drives, their dynamic response and fuel efficient economy combined with the innovative design and variable interior concepts makes the Powercat 46' a real head turner on the water.
