Having blueprinted the ultimate in helm stations, their take on this design satisfies the most discerning of boat critics.

The 'Raised Helm Station' is distinct in its practicalities and styling, being a permanent hard top with opening hatch for ventilation and vision, and the benefit of being able to be fully enclosed to give protection from all elements. Roger Overell, Managing Director/ Builder of Lightwave Yachts comments, "The Skipper can view both bows and sterns as well as the sails from the steering position without leaving the steering wheel or engine controls. This means that the Skipper can maintain safe control of the vessel at all times with minimum effort. When berthing, you can access the side decks directly from the raised helm station, and you can also maintain vision and communication with guests in the galley, saloon, cockpit and deck areas."

Lightwave Yachts are leading the cat charge and standing out amongst the competition due to their unique, innovative features and efficient systems. Each year their cats evolve into more refined vessels that exude presence on the water, having real head turning appeal.

The appeal of the Lightwave range of cruising catamarans has also struck a cord with the ever popular charter market, with the Lightwave 38ft sailing catamaran on display at the show, going straight into charter on Sydney Harbour after the show.
