WORLD DEBUT AT SYDNEY BOAT SHOW

In designing the Serenity 68, Cheoy Lee took the proven concept of an economical, efficient and seaworthy hull and improved on the traditional trawler or expedition styling. The fresh new look was developed by David Bentley Industrial Design Australia. High Modulus in New Zealand engineered the structural design to Germanischer Lloyd class standards, with interior design by Sylvia Bolton in Seattle.

With the Serenity 68, Cheoy Lee has ended up with an efficient, comfortable, roomy and safe sea-going vessel that can just as easily cross oceans as meander along the Australian coastline.

The layout has a spacious saloon with dining table and a galley that would impress any chef. With a king-sized master stateroom, two queen VIP staterooms and a twin guest/crew stateroom, all with large ensuites, there is ample accommodation in this ocean going vessel.

With the price of fuel showing no sign of stopping its upward spiral, this fuel efficient boat will help to keep the running costs down with its twin Caterpillar C7, 315 hp engines sipping about 30 litres an hour at cruise.

The worlds first Serenity 68 has been fitted out with many features over the standard fit-out including Raymarine navigation package, entertainment package with TV's in the Saloon and all staterooms, flybridge hardtop with clears, teak decking, BBQ on the flybridge, tender, second anchor system, espresso coffee machine, galley food processor, inverter system, intercom system, underwater lights, plus much more equipment. To complete the package the vessel comes with cutlery, crockery, kitchenware, cookware and soft furnishing including sheets, towels, bedspreads, pillows and cushions. Cheoy Lee's aim is that when they hand a vessel over to you, all you need to do is bring your provisions and personal gear onboard, turn the key and sail away.
