Description of new product :

Sealegs, the world's first mass produced Amphibious boat, will be exhibiting their new generation Amphibious 7.1m RIB vehicle at the 2008 Sydney International boat show. The Amphibious 7.1m RIB has been specifically designed and developed to take all the hassle out of the boat launching and retrieval process.

The Sealegs system consists of motorised, retractable and steerable wheels which are fitted to specifically designed 7.1m boats to give users a fully integrated, turn-key package. The vessels can seamlessly enter and exit the water at the push of a button, Sealegs works by using powerful motorised wheels which give a variable speed of 0-10km/h powered by an on-board 16hp Honda driven hydraulic power-pack. The hydraulics also lower and raise the wheels when needed ensuring zero drag in the water.

Sealegs recently set a new world record in the 7.1m RIB, crossing the Cook Strait in just 47 minutes, reaching speeds of up to 50 knots. The craft powered faultlessly onto the beach at Owhiro Bay at Wellington after covering a 22km stretch of water.

Unique Features / other information :

The Sealegs amphibious 7.1m RIB vehicle is paired with the Evinrude E-Tec 90-150 outboard motors, enabling the boats to propel through the water at speeds of up to 40 knots. On land, the all-terrain wheels are driven by a small independent four stroke motor couple with a hydraulic pump system powering the boat to speeds of 10kpm on land and 78km/h off.

The Sealegs amphibious boats hydraulics also lower and raise the wheels, much like that of an aeroplane, ensuring zero drag in the water.

Sealegs 7.1m Amphibious Crafts Specifications include; Length Overall 7.1m, Weight (dry) 1100kg, Beam 2.56m, Draft 0.41m, Deadrise 21 degrees, Payload 700kg and 25" X 12" all terrain rear "balloon" tyres on gavinised 9" rims.
