Description of new product :
The Outer Reef 63 is the latest model to be released from Fort Lauderdale based Outer Reef Yachts, who are making their debut at the Sydney International Boat Show this year. The company manufactures semi-custom Raised Pilothouse Motor Yachts from 58 to 115 feet.

Built to satisfy the most discerning of owners, the Outer Reef 63 on display features a light teak interior with 3 staterooms, the largest flybridge in her class, full height engine room and a fuel economy that sets a benchmark in the 8-12 knot passagemaker category of Motor Yachts thanks to the unique design of the semi-displacement hull. Engines are twin Caterpillar 503hp, giving a cruising speed in the 8-12 knot range and a top speed of 16 knots available at the discretion of the owner.

The Outer Reef 63 offers the perfect balance of design, performance, safety and comfort for Australian cruising families. Designed and built with the owner operator in mind, the Outer Reef 63 is rated Open Ocean Category A - wave heights of 18-20' with sustained winds to over 40 knots - for stability and safety.

The Outer Reef 63 returned a total fuel consumption figure of 23 litres per hour at an average of 9 knots on a recent 400 nautical mile passage to Queensland from Pittwater.
